8	A. The "missing and murdered indigenous women task		
9	force" is created and shall exist until the end of fiscal

11	B. The task force consists of:

14	shall be chair of the task force;		
15	(2) the secretary of public safety or the		
16	secretary's designee from the department of public safety;

21	(4) one person who is a member of a pueblo,

1 Mescalero Apache Tribe, appointed by the governor; 2 one person who is a member of the Navajo (7) 3 Nation, appointed by the governor; 4 one person from the office of the (8) 5 medical investigator; (9) one person who is a representative of an 6 7 indigenous women's nongovernmental organization that provides counseling services for indigenous women and girls who have 8 been victims of violence, appointed by the governor; 9 10 (10) one person who is a representative of a statewide or local nongovernmental organization that provides 11 legal services to indigenous women and girls who have been 12 victims of violence, appointed by the governor; and 13 (11)one person who is an indigenous woman 14 15 who has been a victim of violence or a family member of an indigenous woman who has been a victim of violence, appointed 16 by the governor. 17 Vacancies by members of the task force C. 18 appointed by the governor shall be filled by appointment by 19 20 the governor. Task force members appointed by the governor D. 21 may receive per diem and mileage as provided for non-salaried 22 public officers in the Per Diem and Mileage Act and shall 23 receive no other compensation, perquisite or allowance. 24 The task force shall conduct a study to Ε. 25

HAFC/HB 278 Page 2 determine how to increase state resources for reporting and identifying missing and murdered indigenous women in the state. The task force shall collaborate with tribal law enforcement agencies to determine the scope of the problem, identify barriers to address the problem and create partnerships to improve the reporting of and the investigation of missing and murdered indigenous women.

F. The task force shall work with tribal
governments and shall respect tribal sovereignty. The task
force shall collaborate with the United States department of
justice to improve its processes for information sharing and
coordination of resources in regard to reporting and
investigating cases of missing and murdered indigenous women
in the state.

G. The task force shall report its findings and recommendations to the governor, the legislative council service library and the appropriate interim legislative committee and present those findings to the appropriate interim legislative committee prior to November 1, 2020.

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.\_\_\_\_\_

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
