New Mexico Indian Affairs Department issues statement on the passing of Edward T. Begay

Santa Fe – New Mexico Indian Affairs Department Secretary Lynn Trujillo issued the following statement on Monday:

"I join Governor Lujan Grisham and the Navajo Nation in grieving the loss of Edward T. Begay, former Navajo Nation vice chairman and council speaker. Mr. Begay fought to establish the state's first gaming compact and was a prominent champion for legislative redistricting, which enhanced Navajo representation in New Mexico's State Legislature. As a government official, he was instrumental in incorporating traditional, customary, natural, and common law into the Navajo Nation Code.
