#### **IYC Background:**

In early 2021, the IAD established the IYC following two listening sessions that IAD held with tribal youth from across the state. Issues discussed ranged from the desire to have access to higher education resources to behavioral and mental health needs for tribal communities. Participants also voiced the desire to have more intertribal connection between the Nations, Tribes, and Pueblos in the state.

The IYC seeks to elevate indigenous youth voices in the State of New Mexico. This opportunity provides the Council members the opportunity to learn about state government, work with state and tribal leadership, increase representation in various mediums, and cultivate the next generation of Indigenous leaders. IAD provides this space to come together to share mutual experiences, collaborate on shared initiatives, and build community.

Following the previous two cohorts, the IAD seeks applications to serve on the Council to expand our network of Indigenous youth voices from across the state.
