

Indian Affairs Department Matching Federal Funds Infrastructure Grant

The Indian Affairs Department has \$12.5 Million available for matching funds for federal infrastructure grants available to Nations, Pueblos and Tribes of New Mexico.

You may begin submitting applications Friday, December 1, 2023.

Background and Criteria:

Funding: In Fiscal Year 2024, the State Legislature granted the Indian Affairs Department a Special Appropriation for Federal Infrastructure Grants Matching Funds. House Bill 2, Section 5, which makes \$12.5 million available to the Nations, Pueblos, and Tribes of New Mexico as matching funds for Federal Infrastructure Grant Awards.

Application: IAD will begin reviewing submitted applications on Friday, December 15, 2023. After that, applications will be reviewed on a rolling basis.

An application will consist of providing the following information to janelle.frederick@iad.nm.gov:

1. Main point of contact information.
2. A copy of the Tribe, Nation or Pueblo's Notice of Grant Award or Notice of Funding Award.
3. Federal Grant name, grant number, title, and federal agency awarding the grant.
4. Federal grant amount.
5. Request amount for matching funds.

Awardees will be notified via email and phone.

Criteria: Matching funding must be spent by June 30, 2024.
